

THIS YEAR, NEARLY 900 CAMPERS CAME FOR A DOSE OF FUN AND HEALING AT

FLYING HORSE FARMS. It took just about as many volunteers throughout the year to help make camp happen before each session. These "Camp Creators" came from 29 companies and organizations throughout Ohio. Each spent a day cleaning cabins, making beds, restocking supplies, and even pulling weeds – all in an effort to set the stage for healing and magic to happen as soon as campers came through the gate. And while the volunteers worked to support the campers, the participants and companies realized their own benefits as well.

"The Abercrombie & Fitch team has participated in Camp Creator days for several years now," shared Lauren Axell, Associate Relations at Abercrombie & Fitch Co.

"Whether it be our 80+ incoming new hires or 65+ summer interns, we love having the opportunity to expose these groups to what camp is all about." Camp Creator days allow them to truly dive right in and showcase how deep-rooted and meaningful this partnership is to us. It's impossible to not come out of the day feeling like you made a real difference."

During a Camp Creator day experience, teams of volunteers "reset" camp for the next incoming session. Groups clean and replenish areas throughout camp – cabins, activity areas, the grounds, and the Big Red Barn.

"Camp Creator day volunteers' help has been invaluable," said David Hennessey, Chief Property Officer at Flying Horse Farms. "Without them, we simply wouldn't be able to turn camp around as quickly as we do in between sessions. We're grateful for each group that comes to camp and the work they do to help us keep up and repair areas as needed."

In the case of Del-Co Water, they were able to fix a computer that regulates chlorine levels in the pool on their visit. "We're thankful for their support and expertise," said Hennessey. "And when it comes to the pool, I know the kids definitely are too."

AFTER 6 YEARS OF SEARCHING. SETH AND JOSEPH FINALLY FOUND THEIR HOME AWAY FROM HOME.

Colorado natives Seth Olson and Joseph Merwin spent almost a decade volunteering with their local church, mentoring middle- and high-school aged children. Throughout this time, they built strong bonds with the volunteer community there. But after moving to San Francisco and then Columbus, they were unable to find a similar volunteer community experience. "We couldn't find a family or a place that felt like home. We almost gave up on trying to find a place to volunteer that would be a good fit," Joseph recalls.

But when Seth was chosen to volunteer at Flying Horse Farms in 2018 through his employer, Abercrombie & Fitch, and their SeriousFun Camp Counselor program, things brightened. Joseph applied to volunteer the same week, and they were off to camp.

"After the first day, we knew this was the place. I remember we looked at each other across the dining hall and smiled," said Joseph. "We didn't need any words to know our hearts were being filled by being able to love on these kids. We came for the kids, but we keep coming back for the community."

What made camp even better was the fact that, unlike other places they had tried to volunteer,

it didn't matter that Seth and Joseph are a married couple.

"People already embraced us, and it didn't change when people found out we were together," said Seth.


They were blown away by not just the facilities and the medical team, but at how genuine and kind the camp staff was. Most of all, they love the silliness and controlled chaos of camp.

"We've learned so many tools from camp training that I now utilize as a parent. It made me a more patient person," he said. "It prepared me to be the parent I strive to be daily for our two little boys."


