Diagnoses Include:

- Sickle Cell and other hemoglobinopathies
- Hereditary Spherocytosis
- Thrombophilia (Protein C/S/antithrombin deficiency)
- Bone Marrow Failure Disorders: Diamond Blackfan
- Anemia, Fanconi Anemia
- Infusion requirement
- Cancer with active oral chemotherapy
- Previous cancer*
- Hemophilia or other bleeding disorder
- Secondary diagnosis (i.e. MDS, GVHD)
- Chronic ITP
- Significant Vascular Malformations

*May be waitlisted if 3+ years post-treatment with limited complications

Example Program Adaptations:

FHF pays special attention to temperature regulation adaptations (like heating over 3 million gallons of water so campers can swim safely), increases golf cart rides, and has an increased awareness of exposure to bacteria or risk of bleeding from minor injuries.
