


Flying Horse Farms is a registered 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. All our operating costs are underwritten by the generosity of grants, foundations, and community partners.

HOW CAMPERS CHANGED THE WORLD IN 2025

2025 marked 15 years of camp. Year after year, with every session and camper experience, each dose of camp brought friendship, belly laughs, and adventure.

THIS LOOKED LIKE:

Hosting a summer of full sessions: 8 total, including an added summer family camp and more campers in nearly every diagnosis category.

- Over 1,000 camper experiences.
- Nearly 1/3 of campers came for the first time!
- A new rolling admissions process allowed campers who learned about FHF later to still attend as availability opened.

Strengthening the camp community across camper families, volunteers, and seasonal staff.

- 58 families finding camp for the first time.
- 1,900 volunteer experiences.
- 1,400 camp creators across corporate work days;
 - o Completing 110 projects.
 - o Giving 2,700+ volunteer hours – that's more than 112 days!
